The following letter of thanks (with a few editorial changes) was recently received at Wightman UMC. We hear too much about what the Church is NOT doing and too little about what it IS doing. This example of Christian compassion and Church cooperation is evidence that God is still working in and through His Church for the redemption and restoration of the world. Enjoy!

Proverbs 3:5-6

To fellow Christians at Wightman UMC,

"Thank you!" is not adequate for the outpouring of love and generosity that was shown to a child of God, Mary Beth. It was laid on my heart to help her replace the roof on her home when I met her while I was working at the Abundance Food Pantry. I could see how helpless she felt with a leaking roof she could not afford to replace. With all the children she is raising (some of them with special needs), I felt we should help her. So I started asking churches, foundations, businesses and individuals for help.

Our first two bids were close to \$29,000, but we finally got one for \$19, 881. God totally took over and soon we had raised \$16,900. Great Southern Homes stepped up and donated the shingles, which brought the cost down to \$16,881. We now had enough money to replace the roof! But when the old roof was removed some rotten wood was found which required attention. God took care of the extra money we needed, and *Willingham & Sons* said they would do their part to help cover the cost.

This left us with \$41, but we still needed to replace and repaint some rotten boxing at the back of the house. God got to work again! A Lutheran Church in Little Mountain donated their Lenten Offering, a Presbyterian Church in Chapin gave a generous donation and a Presbyterian Friendship Sunday School Class in Newberry all donated money to cover the extra cost.

I cannot say enough about Chapin UMC and Chapin Presbyterian for all the extra work they did on the home in addition to their generous financial donations. Chapin UMC put an extra bathroom in her home (she only had one bathroom for 9 people). They also put in some new windows and a staircase for the attic. Chapin Presbyterian painted the bathroom. (I did not ask for any of this to be done—they came, saw the need and responded.)

Thank you so much, Wightman UMC for your generous donation to this project. Thank you so much for serving the Lord by helping people in need. That is our purpose on this earth—helping one another.

Sunday coffee help needed at the following times:

Task 1: 8:15 AM -9:00 AM - Make 4-8 carafes of coffee and set up the coffee station before first service. Once this is done, another team member can do the next task.

Task 2: 9:45 AM - 10:10AM - Check on the carafes to see if more coffee needs to be made or if empty carafes need to be cleaned and put away. Also check to see if more creamer and sugar need to be put at the coffee station.
